Did You Know...?

More and more, people strive to remain in their own homes as they age in place. As this trend continues to become more popular, there is a growing need for agencies which provide home-based services with the highest level of quality.

One such service is Home Health Care, where qualified professionals come into the home to provide skilled services such as nursing, or physical and occupational therapies. These short-term services are usually paid for by Medicare. Home Health Care can also manage overall care on a continual basis with private services such as medication management and assistance with activities of daily living. Families and patients can benefit from the oversight of a professional nurse.

Another program is Adult Day Care. Families are able to bring loved ones who might need some socialization and activity opportunities they would likely not have available at home to a safe, secure and loving environment for the day. Good food and good friends are the prescribed combination to make clients happy and secure.

The good news is that River Garden offers both of these home-based

The Affordable Care Act (often referred to as Obama Care) has become a catalyst for change as providers everywhere scurry about trying to protect their businesses and market share. Many believe that we will continue to see large care systems com-

First and foremost, care communities like River Garden must remain focused on their core mission, vision and values. With now seven consecutive Governor's Gold Seal Awards for Excellence and consistent 5-star quality ratings from state and federal regulators, River Garden has long been recognized for its unwavering commitment to excellence. And while there are many publicly reported quality measures - and River Garden does well in all of them - most researchers will point to stable and consistent staffing as the single greatest determinant of quality care. At River Garden, we're proud to say that more than 24 percent of our staff has in excess of 10 years of service to the agency. We invite you to look at our

Post acute care: We've now had a number of instances in which hospitalized members of the Jewish community were not advised that they could select River Garden for their post-acute care. As a result they were discharged to other skilled nursing facilities in the community. The reality is that where an individual goes for their post-acute care can make a difference. And so we urge our community to remember that "The Best" is just down the road from them!

On Kol Nidre evening Elliott Palevsky welcomed Fred Tromberg up to the bema to deliver the sermonette.

Yom Kippur morning, Jack Bettman continued his tradition of chanting the haftorah and Marcia Howard, our Shabbat team captain, delivered the sermonette for the second year. During the afternoon Jeff Marks stepped up to continue a long family tradition of chanting the haftorah from the Book of Jonah. For many years, his father, Bernie, of blessed memory, had that honor.

In preparation for Break the Fast, Tina Tadros, Adult Day Care Manager, assisted as sous chef with food prep. Dr. Edwin Safer prepared homemade borscht, made famous by his beloved mother, Mary. Marlene Sussman cooked noodle kugel using the recipe from her mother, Pearl Safer Englander.

It was a pleasure to welcome Rabbi Martin Sandberg to our burgeoning group of volunteers. He was the Rabbi at Beth Shalom until the synagogue closed. Rabbi Sandberg participated throughout the holidays, presenting excellent interpretations of Torah readings on both Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. He is a wonderful addition and we are delighted that the Rabbi has become a Shabbat team captain.

We are deeply grateful to the many members of our Jewish community who provided their special abilities to enhance our beautiful services. We are overwhelmed with joy that so many choose to come here to simply pray with us and share the High Holy Days in a meaningful and spiritual way with our residents, Coves members, board members and families.

The staff built an impressive sukkah which was decorated with much enthusiasm. Residents, staff and guests enjoyed outdoor lunches and casual conversation during the week. Rabbi Tilman, from the Jacksonville Jewish Center, was our guest speaker at our "Lunch and Learn". He delivered a poignant message about the holiday to a large audience.

During Chol Hamoed, the intermediate days of Sukkot, our residents were visited by an energetic group of children and their families from Chabad. With lulav and etrog in hand, residents were invited to say the blessing and then instructed on the proper procedure for shaking. It was a beautiful sight and incredibly meaningful for them to perform the *mitzvah*.

Shemini Atzeres immediately follows the 7 days of Sukkot. Following Shemini Atzeres, the next day we celebrated Simchat Torah - "Joy of the Torah." We read the final Torah portion, then immediately began the new cycle by reading the opening Torah portion, Bereshit, thus reaching the final destination of our spiritual journey which began on Rosh Hashanah.

G-d loves his beloved chosen children, and wants to retain the closeness to each of us. Atzeres means "to retain". May you find a way to retain the inspiration of the festival and may it remain with you for the rest of the year!
